RULES & REGULATIONS

MANAGEMENT

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions regarding or arising from an incident at the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management, their decision to be final.

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to:

- limit, refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel any entries
- disqualify any riders or exhibitors
- prohibit exhibition of entries
- cancel award prizes without claim for damages
- change any course and/or to add a dotted line
- cancel, combine, or reschedule any classes after due notice to exhibitors
- change rings or judges
- change specifications in jumper classes in order to facilitate the time schedule or as competition warrants
- make any changes management deems is in the best interests of the show and as allowed by the USEF.

Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but Management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show, its members, directors, employees, sponsoring entities, and facilities harmless for any loss or accident to his/her horse, horses or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

STALL FEES

Stall are \$85.00 each. Reservations are accepted on a "first pay, first served basis". Stalls will not be reserved without a check. Non-Showing horses will be charged an additional \$40.00. Stabling consists of 10x10 stalls with stall gates. First bedding is not provided, but shavings are available for purchase at a cost of \$8.00 per bag if ordered in advance. Shavings may also be purchased at the show for \$10.00 per bag. Stalls will be available at 10:00 a.m. on Friday. Horses arriving early must make arrangements with and receive approval from Management. All stalls must be reserved online via the website at <http://woodbinefarms.com/h-j-stall-reservations.html>. Reservation is not complete until a stall check is received.

STALL/FACILITY DAMAGE

All stalls are inspected prior to and after the show. Damage to any wood stall will be fined at \$50.00 per incident and damage to vinyl stalls will be fined at \$100.00 per incident. Failure to pay any fines will result in being banned from Woodbine Farm.

HORSE SHOWING OUT OF TRAILERS

There will be a \$30.00 per day grounds fee for horses showing out of trailers.

CAMPERS

The basic camper fee is \$60.00 per show. Campers requiring a 50-amp service will be charged a \$70.00 fee per show. Fee includes electric and water hook ups. Camper spots are limited. Call Sari Clapperton at (502) 314-3411 to reserve a space.

ENTRIES

Entries close one week prior to the show for mailed entries or at 10:00 p.m. on the Thursday immediately prior for online entries. No stalls will be refunded after the mailed entry closing date. There will be a \$25.00 late entry fee per entry after this time. No entries will be taken over the phone. Any trainer or exhibitor who cancels all their stalls will be charged for them regardless of the date. All entry forms must be signed and accompanied by remittance for all fees. Make checks payable to WOODBINE FARMS LLC.

Entry Fees will be refunded only upon presentation of a veterinarian's certificate to the secretary. After entries close, stall fees are non-refundable under any circumstances. Trainers: please send an open barn check to cover any outstanding Sunday balances. There will be a service fee of \$30.00 for any non-negotiable checks.

ADDS/SCRATCHES

All adds and scratches must be done with the Secretary. Adding or scratching with the starter is not enough; you will be charged for any class not scratched in the office.

ELIGIBILITY

Pony and Baby Green eligibility is the responsibility of the Owner/Trainer and begins the first time the Horse or Pony competes over fences. Anyone found in violation of this rule will forfeit any points earned.

PRIZE MONEY

All prize money will be deducted from entries. Prize money exceeding entry fees will be mailed to the owner of record unless otherwise directed within 30 days.

PONY MEASUREMENT

Ponies showing in the pony division may be asked to present a valid pony measurement card at any time. If a measurement card is not able to be produced, the pony shall be presented for measurement immediately at the request of any Woodbine official. All measurement decisions will be considered final for the remainder of the current season.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR

All riders must wear an ASTM/SEI approved riding helmet while mounted anywhere on the show grounds. Any rider violating this rule will be immediately prohibited from further riding until a helmet is in place. Woodbine Farm and Sari Clapperton make no representation or warranty, expressed or implied, about any protective headgear, and cautions riders that serious injury may result despite wearing protective headgear as all equestrian sports involve an intrinsic element of risk.

SCHOOLING

Schooling will be open in the show rings after 12:00 p.m. on Friday. Flat work only will be permitted until 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start time on show days. Management reserves the right to limit schooling in the show rings the morning of the show as needed.

DOTTED LINE

In some classes the area of the courtesy circle may be restricted by a mandatory line. This line will be indicated on the course diagram and physically in the ring.

DOGS

All dogs must always be on a six foot or shorter leash while on the show grounds; this includes hand held dogs. Unattended dogs must be confined to your tack room. No dogs will be allowed in any schooling area or show ring or in the clubhouse. This includes before, during, and after the show. A \$50.00 fine will be assessed per instance if your dog is found to be unleashed on the show grounds at any time. A \$100.00 fine will be assessed if your dog is found to be interfering in any competitor's warm up or competition round.

SHARPS

Competition management is responsible for placing sharps containers in convenient locations on competition grounds and replacing them when full. Competition management may fine any individual up to \$100.00 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

RINGS

All weather footing.

Hunter Ring 1: 250 x 175

Hunter Ring 2: 250 x 150

Jumper Ring: 225 x 100

Schooling Ring: 225 x 100

SHOW CHAMPIONSHIPS

Championships will be offered in all hunter and jumper divisions, as well as walk trot, WTC and poles. Three entries must compete in the first over fences class in hunter divisions and three entries must compete in EACH jumper class for championships to be awarded.

CIRCUIT CHAMPIONSHIP INFORMATION

Riders must compete in the **same division at four of the six shows** to be eligible for the circuit awards. Awards will be presented at the Woodbine Awards Banquet at the end of the season. First through fourth places will be awarded in each hunter, jumper and equitation division.

\$2,500 High Point Hunter- To be awarded to the top three horses with the most points in any two hunter divisions 2' and above. The Woodbine Hunter Classic counts for double bonus points. Classes must have at least three entries to count for points.

\$2,500 High Point Jumper- To be awarded to the top three horses with the most points in any two jumper divisions. Classes must have three entries to count for points.

\$2,500 High Point Trainer- To be awarded to the top three trainers by combining all points earned by all horses under the direction of the trainer. All classes which count toward championships will be included in point tabulation.

(1st - \$1,500 / 2nd - \$750 / 3rd - \$250)

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.

HUNTER DIVISIONS

Entry fee is \$20.00 per class. Course will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as, but not limited to, brush wall, in-out oxer, post and rails, and panels. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners and way of going. Extreme speed will be penalized. All under saddle classes to be shown at a walk, trot and canter in both directions; light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert, responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors. Martingales are not permitted in under saddle classes. Championships in each section will be awarded convenient to the last class in each section. Classes with less than 3 entries may be combined.

WALK TROT

Open to riders in their first year of showing. May cross enter into WTC and poles only.

300-301 Walk Trot Equitation

WALK TROT CANTER

Open to riders who have never shown over fences. Riders may cross enter into poles and crossrails.

POLES

Open to riders of any age in their first year of showing. Multiple riders will be allowed on the same horse. Course to consist of poles on the ground. Riders may only cross enter into walk trot, WTC, and crossrails.

Open to beginner junior and adult riders in their first or second year of showing over fences 2' or lower. Trotting will not be penalized. May choose to cross enter into the poles division or the short stirrup/beginner divisions. Fences: 18".

Open to riders aged eleven years and under. May not cross enter any class which requires the rider to jump 2'3" or higher. Fences: 2'.

Open to riders who have never shown over fences higher than 2'3". Fences: 2'.

Open to riders who have never shown over fences greater than 2'6". No professionals. Fences 2'3".

Open to riders who have never shown over fences 3' or higher. No professionals. Fences: 2'6".

PONY HUNTER

Open to junior riders who have never shown at 2'6" or higher at any type of competition. Any pony found to be competing in a section which is not appropriate for their height will be immediately ineligible and will forfeit any points earned for the season. Any pony may be asked to present a valid measurement card or submit to measurement by Woodbine officials at any time. Fences: Small/Medium 2' and Large 2'3".

Open to all horses and riders. Heights float with divisions. Cards closed during Medals.

Entry fee is \$30.00. Open to all horses. Fences set at all division heights; please declare height with secretary by noon on Saturday. Open numerical scoring. The class will run in a two-round format with the top twelve called back for a handy round weather and time permitting. Riders must be entered and judged in at least 2 over fences classes during the show to be eligible.

Prize: \$250 +50% of entry fees added back: 40% - 25% - 15% - 10% - 5% - 5%

EQUITATION DIVISIONS

Entry fee is \$20.00 per class.

314 CROSSRAILS EQUITATION O/F

Open to very beginner Junior and Adult riders in their first or second year over fences 2' or lower. No tests. Fences: 18".

315 CROSSRAILS EQUITATION OTF

Open to very beginner junior and adult riders in their first or second year of showing over fences 2' or lower. To show at a walk, trot, and canter in both directions of the ring. No test.

316 SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION O/F

Open to riders aged 11 years and under. May not cross enter in any class requiring the rider to jump 2'3" or higher. No Oxers. No Tests. Fences: 2'.

317 SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION OTF

Open to riders aged 11 years and under. May not cross enter in any class requiring the rider to jump 2'3" or higher. To show at a walk, trot, and canter in both directions of the ring.

318 BEGINNER EQUITATION O/F

Open to riders who have never competed over fences higher than 2'3". No tests. Fences: 2'.

319 BEGINNER EQUITATION OTF

Open to riders who have never competed over fences higher than 2'3". To show at a walk, trot, and canter in both directions of the ring.

320 NOVICE EQUITATION O/F

Open to riders who have never shown over fences greater than 2'6". Fences: 2'3".

321 NOVICE EQUITATION OTF

Open to riders who have never shown over fences greater than 2'6". To show at a walk, trot, and canter in both directions of the ring. Tests 1-7 optional.

322 LIMIT EQUITATION O/F

Open to riders who have never shown over fences 3' or higher. Fences: 2'6"

323 LIMIT EQUITATION OTF

Open to riders who have never shown over fences 3' or higher. To show at a walk, trot, and canter in both directions of the ring. Tests 1-7 optional.

324 JUNIOR ADULT EQUITATION O/F

Open to any amateur adult or junior rider. Tests 1-10 optional. Fences: 2'9".

325 JUNIOR-ADULT EQUITATION OTF

Open to any amateur adult or junior rider. To show at a walk, trot, and canter in both directions of the ring. Tests 1-10 optional.

326 PONY EQUITATION O/F

Open to junior riders who have never shown at 2'6" or higher. Ponies must compete at their respective heights, see pony hunter for further information. Tests 1-7 optional. Fences: Small/Medium 2' and Large 2'3".

327 PONY EQUITATION OTF

Open to junior riders on ponies. To show at the walk, trot, and canter in both directions of the ring. Test 1-7 optional.

328 LEADLINE

Open to riders of any age who have never shown independently. To be led by a handler aged sixteen years or older at the walk only.

MEDALS

The twelve riders that earn the most points during the first five shows will be eligible to compete in the Medal Finals at the September show. Riders may compete in multiple medals during the season but must choose only one medal final to compete in should they be eligible for multiple finals.

Entry fee is \$25.00. Open to any eligible beginner equitation rider. Test on course. Fences: 2'.

331 Woodbine Novice Medal

Entry fee is \$25.00. Open to any eligible novice rider. Test on course. Fences: 2'3".

332 Woodbine Junior-Adult Medal

Entry fee is \$25.00. Open to any eligible junior or adult equitation rider. Test on course. Fences: 2'9".

333 Woodbine Pony Medal

Entry fee is \$25.00. Open to any junior on a pony. Test on course. Fences: Small/Medium 2' and Large 2'6".

334 Woodbine Limit Medal

Entry fee is \$25.00. Open to any eligible limit rider. Test on course. Fences: 2'6".

JUMPER DIVISIONS

Entry fee is \$20.00 per class. Add back is \$25.00 per class.

A computer-generated random *Order of Go* may be posted for all jumper classes. In case of a tie for other than first place, time in the first round shall break the tie. A champion and reserve title will be awarded to the two horses that have acquired the most points in each section with at least three entries in each class. Add back classes count for 1.5 times points. In the event of a tie, a higher placing in the add back class will determine placings. To be judged Table II.2b unless otherwise noted. Classes with less than three entries may be combined. One rider per horse in each class.

Open to any horse or rider in their first 2 years of showing.
