EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

2020 USE Membership Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National

Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

Federation Entry Agreement

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry form as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc., (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation, The World Equestrian Center, and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

Statement as to Federation Fee

(GR407.1-3) For every horse participating in any competition licensed by the Federation, a \$23 Federation Fee will be collected (\$15 shall be an Equine Drugs & Medication Fee to provide for research, inspection and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs). The Horse Show Management reserves the right in itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of an incident without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management, their decision to be final. The Horse Show Management reserves the right to limit entries, refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or judges; to change specifications in jumper classes in order to facilitate the time schedule or as competition warrants, or make any changes management deems is in the best interest of the show and its exhibitors. Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but Management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show, its members, directors and employees, contractors, sponsoring entities and facility harmless for any loss or accident to horse, horses or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

Motorized Vehicle Statement

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but

not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

CORONAVIRUS DISEASE RESOURCES AND UPDATES

In addition to requirements set forth by the USEF, participants will also be expected to adhere to current state and local health requirements at the time of competition.

RULES & REGULATIONS

Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but Management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show, its members, directors and employees, contractors, sponsoring entities and facility harmless for any loss or accident to horse, horses or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

ADDS/SCRATCHES

All adds and scratches must be done with the secretary before the judge's card closes unless otherwise noted. Adding or scratching with the starter is insufficient; you will be charged for any class not scratched in the office.

CAMPERS

The camper fee is \$200.00 per show. Fee includes electric and water hook ups. Camper spots are limited. Call Sari Clapperton at (502) 314-3411 to reserve a space. Availability is limited.

DOGS

Dogs and other pets must always be on a six foot or shorter leash while on the show grounds; this includes hand held pets. Unattended pets must be confined to your tack room. No pets will be allowed in any schooling area or show ring or in the clubhouse. This includes before, during, and after the show. A \$50.00 fine will be assessed per instance if your pet is found to be unleashed on the show grounds at any time. A \$100.00 fine will be assessed if your pet is found to be interfering in any competitor's warm up or competition round. Please do not tie dogs in aisles as they are a danger to passing horses and people.

GROUNDS FEES

A Grounds Fee of \$50.00 per day will be charged to exhibitors stabling off the grounds or showing out of a trailer.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (rhino-pneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. All horses must have valid proof of negative Coggins test (within 12 months). A 30-day certificate of veterinary inspection is required for all horses arriving from outside the state of Michigan.

MEASUREMENT

The secretary should be notified upon arrival if a horse or pony will need to be measured. Measurement scheduling will be determined by the Horse Show Manager.

MICROCHIPPING

Mandatory Microchipping went into effect on December 1, 2018. You will not be allowed to COMPETE any horse that has not been micro-chipped. More information can be found on the USEF website at usef.org.

PAYMENT AND NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS

Payment is permitted by cash and check. A signed, open check must be given to the secretary at check in to cover the costs of the horse show expenses. Checks should be made payable to "Woodbine Farm". Stall fees must be paid in full and in advance to secure the stall reservation. Back numbers will not be released without a signed, open check, documentation of required memberships as outlined by the USEF, and entry form signatures. All foreign exhibitors must pay by cash or check drawn on a US bank.

Any non-negotiable check will be charged a collection fee of \$50.00. Riders must check out at the completion of the show. Entries may be denied based on prior offenses or may be subject to cash only payment.

PRIZE MONEY

An Internal Revenue Service Form W-9 needs to be completed showing the proper prize money recipient and their social security number or federal identification number. Care must be taken to be sure the

information matches that of the IRS. Prize money will be deducted from your account upon closeout in the office provided you have submitted the required Form W-9. Balances will be paid in the form of a check mailed to the named recipient on the Form W-9 within 30 days after the conclusion of the show. The Form W-9 is available in the show office.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR

All riders must wear an ASTM/SEI approved riding helmet while mounted anywhere on the show grounds. Any rider violating this rule will be immediately prohibited from further riding until a helmet is in place. Woodbine Farm and Sari Clapperton make no representation or warranty, expressed or implied, about any protective headgear, and cautions riders that serious injury may result despite wearing protective headgear as all equestrian sports involve an intrinsic element of risk. Additionally, footwear worn while riding anywhere on the competition grounds must have a distinguishable heel.

REFUNDS

Entry fees will be refunded only on receipt of a signed veterinarian's certificate. Once the show has started, the certificate must be issued by the official show veterinarian. There are no refunds on stalls or administrative fees. If the show must be stopped due to weather, accident, or other emergency, the show management has the right to deny a refund of any or all fees.

SAFESPORT

As of January 1, 2019, every USEF adult member (18 years of age or older) with a Competing Membership must complete USEF's Safe Sport Training. No exceptions allowed.

SCHOOLING

Schooling will be open in the show rings after 12:00 p.m. on Wednesday. Flat work only will be permitted until 45 minutes prior to the scheduled start time on show days, weather permitting. Management reserves the right to limit schooling in the show rings the morning of the show as needed. Longeing is permitted in designated areas only.

SHARPS

Competition management is responsible for placing sharps containers in convenient locations on competition grounds and replacing them when full. Competition management may fine any individual up to \$100.00 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

SMOKING

Smoking and vaping are not permitted in any barn area. Cigarette butts and other smoking debris must be disposed of properly.

STABLING

Stall fees are \$185.00 per stall per show. Reservations are accepted on a “first pay, first served basis” and Management reserves the right to limit tack stalls. Horses may not share a stall. Stalls will not be reserved without a check. Non-Showing horses will be charged an additional \$75.00. Stabling consists of 10x10 wooden or vinyl, permanent or temporary stalls with stall gates and a clay floor. First bedding is not provided, but shavings are available for purchase at a cost of \$8.00 per bag. No feed, hay, or straw will be available for purchase.

Stalls will be available at 9:00 a.m. on the Wednesday prior to the show. Horses arriving early must make arrangements with and receive approval from Management and will be subject to a \$60 per day additional charge. All stalls must be reserved online via the website at <http://woodbinefarms.com/h-j-stall-reservations.html>. Reservations from www.horseshowing.com will not be accepted. Reservation is not complete until a stall check is received.

STALL/FACILITY DAMAGE

All stalls are inspected prior to and after the show. Damage to any wood stall will be fined at \$50.00 per incident and damage to vinyl stalls will be fined at \$100.00 per incident. Failure to pay any fines will result in being banned from Woodbine Farm.

USEF & USHJA CREDENTIALS

Memberships will be electronically verified with the USEF/USHJA. If you submit a COMPLETE entry blank, including all required numbers and signatures, you will not be required to show your membership cards, measurement cards, or recording cards. We WILL NOT look up your numbers for you. If you have applied recently, online, you will be given an instant number so include it on your entry. Mailed memberships are not verifiable for at least 30 days, please do not mail any memberships prior to the show, you will be required to pay the non-member fee. All owners, riders, and trainers must be current members of USEF and USHJA or pay non-member fees of \$45 USEF and \$30 USHJA. Riders in classes restricted to Amateurs must hold USEF Amateur certification; they may not pay the non-member fee. GR208 Statement as to Federation Fee: For every horse participating in any competition licensed by the Federation, a \$23 Federation Fee will be collected (\$15 shall be an Equine Drugs & Medication Fee to provide for research, inspection and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs and the USHJA fee is \$8).

Hunter Classes

All hunter classes to be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise indicated.

Courses will consist of at least eight fences with changes of direction. Fences will simulate obstacles found in the hunt field, such as brush, post and rails, walls, in and outs, gates, etc. In some cases, the area of the courtesy circle may be restricted by a dotted line. Handy Hunters Courses in all “A” rated hunter division to use tracks and jumps found in trappy hunt country, and may include natural obstacles, a trot fence, etc. (except for Young Hunter, Green Pony Hunters, and 3’/3’3” Green Hunters). Management reserves the right to restrict the area of the courtesy circle, which will be clearly marked on the course chart and publicly announced with a corresponding barrier erected in the ring.

Under Saddle classes to be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. No martingales permitted. In High Performance, A/O and Junior classes, entries may be asked to hand gallop collectively one way of the ring, at the Judge's discretion. No more than eight shall be asked to hand gallop at one time.

Sections may be combined or cancelled if entries warrant. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 8th place. A Championship and Reserve title will be awarded in all hunter sections. Points awarded for all divisions as follows: 10-6-4-2-1-½. Prize money to be distributed as follows: 30%-22%-15%-12%-11%-10% in all hunter classes and a minimum of three riders must compete to receive prize money excepting the USHJA National Hunter Derby.

Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 8th place. A Championship and Reserve title will be awarded in all jumper divisions except where noted. Points used will be 10-6-4-2-1-½, except the bonus class which will be 15-9-6-3-2-1. In the event of a tie, the higher placing in the bonus class will break the tie.
