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## HEALTH & SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

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### COMPLIANCE

Failure to comply with any of the health and safety requirements or newly implemented procedures may result in removal from the grounds. Refunds will not be issued in cases of non compliance.

### FACE MASKS

All participants and staff are required to wear a facemask or face covering when in any outdoor setting where there is a possibility of being within six feet of other individuals. Face masks are required at all times in the stables. A participant will not be penalized for wearing a face mask or covering while competing.

## **SELF MONITORING**

All participants and staff are required to self-monitor their temperature once daily prior to entering the competition grounds. Anyone with a temperature of 99.5° F or higher may not enter the grounds. Furthermore, anyone (1) experiencing any form of illness, including symptoms not typically consistent with Covid-19, (2) that has tested positive for Covid-19 in the past two weeks, or (3) has been in contact with someone that has tested positive for Covid-19 in the past two weeks may not enter the grounds.

## **SOCIAL DISTANCING**

All participants and staff are required to practice social distancing when on the property. Farms are restricted from setting up common seating areas in the barn area. Exhibitors may set up tents along the rings for shade so long as they are properly staked and social distancing and/or the use of masks is observed. When social distancing is not possible, a face mask or covering is required.

## **SPECTATORS**

In general, spectators are prohibited until further notice. Exhibitors under the age of 18 are permitted one adult companion for the duration of the competition.

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## **OFFICE PROCEDURES**

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### **CHECK IN**

Trainers will be responsible for checking in exhibitors; individual check in will not be permitted. Trainer packets will be available for pick up outside of the office beginning at noon on Friday. Packets will include:

- Entries (signatures required)
- Trainer report
- Splits
- Show Schedule
- Prize List (personal copy)
- Health screening tool
- USE best practices guidance
- CDC recommendations

Trainers must return completed packet by 5:00 p.m. on Friday to receive back numbers. Completed packet must include:

- Signed entries
- Updated trainer report

- Updated splits
- Blank check for each entry or blank barn check

### **CHECK OUT**

Trainers will be responsible for checking out all entries. Individual check out will not be permitted. Check out will be available on Sunday only. Statements will be available to trainers for review on Sunday morning by 8:00 a.m. Questions or disputes must be submitted by noon on Sunday; adjustments will not be made beyond that time. Paid statements will be provided to each trainer for distribution to clients.

### **ENTRIES**

All entries must be completed online at [www.horseshowing.com](http://www.horseshowing.com); paper entries will no longer be accepted. Completed online entries are due one week prior to the start of the competition. A late fee of \$30 will be assessed after that date. Same day and incomplete entries (entries with no classes) will not be accepted.

### **FORMS**

Daily schedules, trainer reports, and daily trainer schedules will be available in trainer files each morning by 8:00 a.m. outside the office. All other forms and schedules, including add/drop forms, will be made available under the office tent. Areas will be clearly marked.

### **RESTRICTED ENTRY**

Admittance to the office will be restricted. The secretary will be available by email and text during posted office hours. Window service will be available under the office tent for trainers to check in and check out.

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## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

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### **MANAGEMENT**

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions regarding or arising from an incident at the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management, their decision to be final.

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to:

- limit, refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel any entries
- disqualify any riders or exhibitors
- prohibit exhibition of entries

- cancel award prizes without claim for damages
- change any course and/or add a dotted line
- cancel, combine, or reschedule any classes after due notice to exhibitors
- change rings or judges
- change specifications in jumper classes in order to facilitate the time schedule or as competition warrants
- modify the prize list for clarifications as warranted
- make any changes management deems is in the best interests of the show.

Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but Management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show, its members, directors, employees, sponsoring entities, and facilities harmless for any loss or accident to his/her horse, horses or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

#### **STALL FEES**

Stall fees are \$85.00 per stall. Reservations are accepted on a “first pay, first served basis”. Stalls will not be reserved without a check. Stabling consists of 10x10 stalls with stall gates. Stalls will be available at 10:00 a.m. on Friday. Horses arriving early must make arrangements with and receive approval from Management. All stalls must be reserved online via the website at <http://woodbinefarms.com/h-j-stall-reservations.html>. Reservation is not complete until a stall check is received. Stall fees are non-refundable once the mailed entry deadline has passed.

#### **BEDDING**

First bedding is not provided, but shavings are available for purchase at a cost of \$8.00 per bag if ordered in advance. **Shavings will not be available for purchase at the show.** ~~Shavings may also be purchased at the show for \$10.00 per bag.~~ Unused shavings may not be returned. Bedding may be ordered online via the website at <http://woodbinefarms.com/h-j-stall-reservations.html>.

#### **STALL/FACILITY DAMAGE**

All stalls are inspected prior to and after the show. Damage to any wood stall will be fined at \$50.00 per incident and damage to vinyl stalls will be fined at \$100.00 per incident. Failure to pay any fines will result in being banned from Woodbine Farm.

#### **NON-SHOWING HORSE**

Non-showing horses will be charged a \$50.00 fee plus all applicable stall and bedding charges and must be recorded in the show office on an entry blank.

#### **HORSE SHOWING OUT OF TRAILERS**

There will be a \$40.00 per day grounds fee for horses showing out of trailers.

## **CAMPERS**

The basic camper fee is \$70.00 per show. Campers requiring a 50-amp service will be charged a \$80.00 fee per show. Fee includes electric and water hook ups. Camper spots are limited. Call Sari Clapperton at (502) 314-3411 to reserve a space.

## **ENTRIES**

~~Mailed entries close one week prior to the show. Online entries close on the Tuesday prior to the show.~~ **Online entries close Saturday prior to show. Paper and incomplete entries (entries with no classes) will be rejected.** A \$30.00 late fee will be applied to entries received after the respective deadlines with no exceptions. No entries will be taken over the phone, **by mail, or by email.**

## **ADDS/SCRATCHES**

All adds and scratches must be done with the Secretary before the judge's card closes. Adding or scratching with the starter is not sufficient. Riders will be charged for any class not scratched in the office within the time allowed. **Forms will be available outside of the office alongside a drop box. Adds and drops are only permitted on Saturday; they are not permitted on Sunday. Entries must be completed by 5:00 p.m. on Saturday for Sunday's competition.**

## **REFUNDS**

Entry fees will be refunded only on receipt of a signed veterinarian's certificate. There are no refunds on stalls or administrative fees. If the show must be stopped due to weather, accident, or other emergency, the show management has the right to deny a refund of any or all fees.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

Pony and Baby Green eligibility is the responsibility of the Owner/Trainer and begins the first time the Horse or Pony competes over fences. Anyone found in violation of this rule will forfeit any points earned.

## **NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS**

Entry forms must be signed and accompanied by an open check made payable to Woodbine Farm. A \$50.00 service fee will be assessed for any non-negotiable checks.

## **PRIZE MONEY**

All prize money will be deducted from entries. Prize money exceeding entry fees will be mailed to the owner of record unless otherwise directed within 30 days.

## **PRIZES**

**Ribbons may not be made available until the close of the show dependent on current guidance and best practices. Should distribution throughout the show not be workable, ribbons, including**

champion and reserve ribbons and/or prizes, will be packaged by entry number and available for pick up by trainers on Sunday at check out.

### **PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR**

All riders must wear an ASTM/SEI approved riding helmet while mounted anywhere on the show grounds. Any rider violating this rule will be immediately prohibited from further riding until a helmet is in place. Woodbine Farm and Sari Clapperton make no representation or warranty, expressed or implied, about any protective headgear, and cautions riders that serious injury may result despite wearing protective headgear as all equestrian sports involve an intrinsic element of risk.

### **ELECTRONIC DEVICES**

The unsafe use of electronic devices, as determined by the Horse Show Management in their sole discretion, including cell phones, with or without earphones/buds while mounted is prohibited in all areas designated for schooling and exercise, and while lungeing horses on competition grounds. Violators will be penalized at the discretion of the Horse Show Management.

### **SCHOOLING**

Schooling will be open in the show rings after 12:00 p.m. on Friday. Flat work only will be permitted until 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start time on show days. Management reserves the right to limit schooling in the show rings the morning of the show as needed.

### **DOTTED LINE**

In some classes the area of the courtesy circle may be restricted by a mandatory line. This line will be indicated on the course diagram and physically in the ring.

### **DOGS**

All dogs must always be on a six foot or shorter leash while on the show grounds; this includes hand held dogs. Unattended dogs must be confined to your tack room. No dogs will be allowed in any schooling area or show ring or in the clubhouse. This includes before, during, and after the show. A \$50.00 fine will be assessed per instance if your dog is found to be unleashed on the show grounds at any time. A \$100.00 fine will be assessed if your dog is found to be interfering in any competitor's warm up or competition round.

### **SMOKING**

Smoking, vaping or any similar activity is strictly prohibited in any building. Proper disposal of smoking materials will be enforced.



## **SHARPS**

Competition management is responsible for placing sharps containers in convenient locations on competition grounds and replacing them when full. Competition management may fine any individual up to \$100.00 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

All weather footing.

## **SHOW CHAMPIONSHIPS**

Championships will be offered in all hunter, equitation and jumper divisions unless otherwise noted. Three entries must compete in the first over fences class in hunter and equitation divisions and three entries must compete in EACH jumper class for championships to be awarded.

## **CIRCUIT CHAMPIONSHIP INFORMATION**

Riders in each division are eligible for the year end circuit awards presented at the annual Woodbine Awards Banquet. First through fourth places will be awarded in each hunter, jumper and equitation division.

Points are cumulative and include all points awarded in each division throughout the season. In the event that a division does not fill at a particular show, half points will be awarded and will be used in calculating the year end cumulative points.

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## **HUNTER DIVISIONS**

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Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as, but not limited to, brush wall, in-out, oxer, post and rails, and panels with changes in direction. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners and way of going. Extreme speed will be penalized. All under saddle classes to be shown at a walk, trot and canter in both directions. Martingales are not permitted in under saddle classes.

Classes with less than 3 entries may be combined. Placings will be awarded to the top 8 entries in each class. Points awarded for all divisions as follows: 10-6-4-2-1-1/2. Prize money in Handy Hunter classes to be awarded as follows: 40% - 25% - 15% - 10% - 5% - 5%. Minimum of 3 entries required in Handy Hunter classes to receive prize money.

### **BABY GREEN HUNTER**

Open to horses in their first or second year of showing over fences. Fences: 2'- 2'3".

### **PONY HUNTER**

Open to junior riders who have never shown over fences higher than 2'6". Riders may choose the fence height, but must remain at that height for the entire show season. Cross entry eligibility is restricted according to age, fence heights and abilities. Fence heights must be honored in the Woodbine Hunter Classic. Any pony found to be competing in a section which is not appropriate for their age, height or abilities will be immediately ineligible and will forfeit any points earned for the season. Fence heights: 2'/2'3"/2'6".

**\$250 WOODBINE HUNTER CLASSIC**

Open to all eligible horses and riders. Entry must compete in at least one hunter class to be eligible. Entries and fence height declarations should be finalized by noon on Saturday. A computer-generated order of go will be posted by 2:00 p.m. on Saturday and will be strictly enforced. Entries are permitted to scratch without penalty until the class begins. No scratches are permitted beyond that time. Late entries will be accepted and placed at the top of the order. Any horse and rider combination that has won two Woodbine Hunter Classic classes (consecutive or nonconsecutive) is restricted from entering again for the remainder of the season. Minimum of six entries required to receive prize money.

Fences set at all division heights. Declared fence height must be consistent with division(s) that rider is competing in at the show. Open numerical scoring. The class will run in a two-round format with the top twelve called back for a handy round weather and time permitting. Riders must be entered and judged in at least 2 over fences classes during the show to be eligible. Prize: \$250 + 50% of entry fees added back to be awarded as follows: 40% - 25% - 15% - 10% - 5% - 5%.

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**EQUITATION DIVISIONS**

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Cross entry restrictions may apply. See respective Hunter Division for cross entry restrictions unless otherwise noted. Open to non-professional junior and adult riders. Entry must compete in at least one jumper class to be eligible. Entries must be finalized by 8:00 a.m. on Saturday. A computer-generated order of go will be posted by 8:30 a.m. on Saturday and will be strictly enforced. Any horse and rider combination that has won two Woodbine Gamblers Choice classes (consecutive or nonconsecutive) is restricted from entering again for the remainder of the season. Minimum of six entries required to receive prize money. Prize money is awarded as follows: 40% - 25% - 15% - 10% - 5% - 5%. Fences 2'6". Refer to USEF rulebook JP 149 for full class specifications.

1. One round timed class (speed class).
2. Fences will have a point value of 10-120 points.
3. Riders will create their own course.
4. Fences can be jumped in both directions.
5. 60 seconds will be allotted for jumping efforts. At 60 seconds the horn will sound indicating that no more jumping efforts will be counted. If a horse has started a jumping effort when the horn sounds, that fence value will be counted.
6. Knockdowns will not be reset or counted for points. Refusals are penalized by the time taken.
7. Riders MUST go through the Start and Finish markers.
8. Ties are broken by the total time taken between the start and finish lines.
