RULES & REGULATIONS

MANAGEMENT

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of an incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules/Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management, their decision to be final.

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to limit entries, refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or judges; to change specifications in jumper classes in order to facilitate the time schedule or as competition warrants, or make any changes management deems is in the best interests of the show.

Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but Management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show, its members, directors and employees, sponsoring entities, and facility harmless for any loss or accident to his horse, horses or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

STALL FEES

Stall fees are \$85.00 each. Reservations are accepted on a "first pay, first serve basis". Stalls will not be reserved without a check! Please call early. Non-Showing horses will be charged an additional \$40.00. Stabling consists of 10x10 stalls with stall gates. First bedding is not provided, but shavings are available upon request (\$8/bag). Stalls will be available at 11:00 A.M. on Friday. Horses coming in early must make arrangements with the management.

STALL/FACILITY DAMAGE – All stalls are inspected prior to and after the show. Damage to any wood stall will be fined \$50/ incident and damage to vinyl stalls will be \$100/ incident. Failure to pay any fines will result in being banned from Woodbine.

HORSE SHOWING OUT OF TRAILERS

There will be a \$30 per day grounds fee for horses showing out of trailers.

CAMPERS

Camper Fee \$60.00 per show. Electric and Water hook up. Limited availability. Please use the camper reservation form on woodbinefarms.com to reserve a space.

ENTRIES

Mailed entries close ONE WEEK BEFORE SHOW, online entries close the Thursday prior to the show. You will be charged for stall cancellations made less than 7 days in advance. There will be a \$25.00 Late Entry Fee per entry after the closing deadline. No entries will be taken over the phone. Any trainer or exhibitor who cancels all of their stalls will be charged for them regardless of the date. All entry forms must be signed and accompanied by remittance for all fees. Makes checks payable to **WOODBINE FARMS LLC**. Entry Fees will be refunded only upon presentation of a veterinarian's certificate to the secretary. Stall fees are non-refundable under any circumstances. TRAINERS: Please send open Barn Check to cover any outstanding Sunday balances. **There will be a service fee of \$50 for any non-negotiable checks.**

ADDS/SCRATCHES

All adds and scratches must be done with the secretary, to avoid a ridden not entered (RNE) fee of \$5 per class. Adding or scratching with the starter is not sufficient.

PRIZE MONEY

All prize money will be deducted from entries. Prize Money exceeding entry fees will be mailed to the owner of record unless otherwise directed within 30 days.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR

All riders must wear an ASTM/SEI approved riding helmet while mounted anywhere on the show grounds (Professionals included). Any rider violating this rule will be immediately prohibited from further riding until the headgear is properly in place. WOODBINE FARM & SARI CLAPPERTON make no representation or warranty, expressed or implied, about any protective headgear, and cautions riders that serious injury may result despite wearing protective headgear as all equestrian sports involve an intrinsic element of risk.

SCHOOLING

Schooling will be permitted in the show rings after 12:00 P.M. on Friday and until ½ hour prior to commencement the days of the show. Any schooling sessions during the show will be announced and listed on the daily schedule.

DOTTED LINE

In some classes the area of the courtesy circle may be restricted by a mandatory line. This line will be indicated on the course diagram and physically in the ring.

DOGS

All DOGS must be leashed. Dogs must be leashed at ALL TIMES while on the show grounds, (including hand held dogs). All dogs must be in your tack room or on a leash. No dogs will be allowed in any schooling area or show ring or in the clubhouse. This means BEFORE, DURING and AFTER the show.

SHARPS

Competition Management is responsible for placing Sharps containers in convenient locations on competition grounds and replacing them when full. Competition Management may fine any individual up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

RINGS

Indoor Ring: 72x200 Sand Outdoor Schooling Ring (weather permitting): 100x225 Sand

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS: All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.

Hunter Divisions:

Entry Fee: \$20 per class

Course will simulate fences found in the Hunting Field such as, brush wall, in-out oxer, post and rails, aiken and panels. To be judged on performance and soundness, manners and way of going. Extreme speed will be penalized. All Under Saddle Classes to be shown at a Walk, Trot & Canter both ways in the ring, light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Horses should be obedient, alert, responsive and move freely. They should not be eliminated for slight errors. Martingales are not permitted in Under Saddle classes. Championships in each section will be awarded convenient to the last class in each section. Classes with less than 3 entries may be combined.

WALK TROT

Riders in their 1st year of showing. May cross enter into W-T-C and poles only.

300-302 Walk Trot Eq

301-303 Walk Trot Hunter

WALK TROT CANTER

Open to riders who have never shown over fences. Riders may cross enter into pole piles and crossrails.

304-306 W-T-C Eq

305-307 W-T-C Hunter

POLES

Open to riders of any age in their first year of showing. Multiple riders will be allowed on the same horse.

Course to consist of poles on the ground. Riders may only cross enter into WT/ WTC and Crossrails.

Open to beginner Junior and Adult riders in their 1st or 2nd year over fences 2' or lower. Trotting will not be penalized. May choose to cross enter into the Poles division OR the Short Stirrup/ Beginner Division. Fences: 18"

SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER

Open to riders 11 & under. May not cross enter any class which requires the rider to jump 2'3" or higher. Fences: 2'

BEGINNER HUNTER

Open to riders who have never competed over fences higher than 2'3". Fences: 2'

1-2-3-4 Beginner Hunter

Open to horses in their first or second year of showing over fences. Fences: 2' - 2'3"

6-7-8-9 Baby Green Hunter

10 Baby Green Hunter Under Saddle

NOVICE HUNTER

Open to riders who have never shown over fences greater than 2'6". No professionals. Fences 2'3"

11-12-13-14 Novice Hunter

15 Novice Hunter Under Saddle

LIMIT HUNTER

Open to riders who have never shown over fences 3' or higher. No professionals. Fences: 2'6"

Open to all horses, ponies & riders. Riders to declare fence height at the gate. Heights to be judged together. Fences: 2'9 or 3'

Open to all horses/riders. Heights float with divisions. Cards closed during Medals.

EQUITATION DIVISION

Entry Fee: \$20 per Class

316 SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION – O/F

Open to riders 11 & Under. May not cross enter in any class requiring the rider to jump 2'3" or higher. No Oxers. No Tests. Fences: 2'

317 SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION – FLAT

Open to riders 11 & Under. May not cross enter in any class requiring the rider to jump 2'3" or higher. To show at a walk-trot-canter both directions of the ring.

318 BEGINNER EQUITATION O/F

Open to riders who have never competed over fences higher than 2'3". No tests. Fences: 2'

319 BEGINNER EQUITATION – FLAT

Open to riders who have never competed over fences higher than 2'3". To show at a walk-trot-canter both directions of the ring.

320 NOVICE EQUITATION O/F

Open to riders who have never shown over fences greater than 2'6". Fences: 2'3"

321 NOVICE EQUITATION – FLAT

Open to riders who have never shown over fences greater than 2'6". To show at a walk-trot-canter both directions of the ring. Tests 1-7 optional.

322 LIMIT EQUITATION O/F

Open to riders who have never shown over fences 3' or higher. Fences: 2'6"

323 LIMIT EQUITATION – FLAT

Open to riders who have never shown over fences 3' or higher. To show at a walk-trot-canter both directions of the ring. Tests 1-7 optional.

324 JUNIOR ADULT EQUITATION O/F

Open to any amateur adult or junior rider. Tests 1-10 optional. Fences: 2'9"

325 JUNIOR-ADULT EQUITATION – FLAT

Open to any amateur adult or junior rider. To show at a walk-trot-canter both directions of the ring. Tests 1-10 optional.

MEDALS

330 WOODBINE BEGINNER MEDAL

Entry Fee: \$25

Open to any eligible beginner equitation rider. Test on course. Fences: 2'

331 WOODBINE NOVIC/LIMIT MEDAL

Entry Fee: \$25

Open to any eligible novice or limit rider. Test on course. Fences: 2'3" -2'6"

332 WOODBINE JUNIOR -ADULT MEDAL

Entry Fee: \$25

Open to any eligible junior or adult equitation rider. Test on course. Fences: 2'9"

JUMPER DIVISIONS:

Entry Fee: \$20 per class/ Add Back \$25 per class

A computer generated random Order of Go may be posted for all Jumper Classes. In case of a tie for other than first place, time in the first round shall break the tie. A Champion & Reserve title will be awarded to the 2 horses which have acquired the most points in each section with at least 3 entries in each class. Add back class to count for 1.5 times points. In the event of a tie, higher placing in add back class will determine placings. To be judged Table II.2b unless otherwise noted. Classes with less than 3 entries may be combined. One rider per horse.

CROSSRAILS JUMPER

Open to any horse or rider in their first 2 years of showing.

LOW JUMPER 2'

Open to horses or riders who have never jumped higher than 2'6". Horse/Rider combinations may not cross enter into any class greater than 2'6".

204-205-206 Low Jumper

Open to all horses and riders. May not cross enter into any class greater than 3'

208-209-210 Schooling Jumper

Open to all horses and riders.
